The purpose of the Graduation Project is to give students an opportunity to integrate knowledge from across the curriculum and exhibit the skills they have acquired throughout their educational journey. The project allows students to explore topics of their choice and *apply* their knowledge by creating, serving, or experiencing something new.

Your support and participation in this endeavor is invaluable. Please familiarize yourself with your child's topic and product choice and the expectations listed below; **check each box as you read and sign at the bottom.**

- I have read the proposal and approve of the product chosen by my child.
- East Duplin High School is not responsible for transportation or expenses associated with Graduation Project.
- The product portion of the project requires a minimum of 15 documented activity hours. These hours are to be completed after school, on weekends, or over breaks. Time used filling out paper work, working on the power point, or meeting with the teacher advisor does not count towards the 15 hours.
- East Duplin High School is not responsible for any injury received by the student during the course of the Graduation Project field work and/or product work.
- The product must be chosen from one of these categories: job shadowing, making/building/creating a product, volunteering/community service, learning a new skill, fundraising. If the product does not fall into one of these categories, special permission must be given by the graduation project committee.
- Students may not job shadow immediate family members or family members that may reside in the home with the student.
- The product must be approved by the GRAD Project committee and completed as approved. If the student wishes to change his or her graduation project product a new proposal must be submitted to the committee and approved by the date given in the timeline.
- This project is not only a test of skill but integrity; plagiarism, forgery, cheating, or any form of dishonesty will result in failure of the project and the inability to participate in the graduation ceremony. The decision will be up to the committee if the project can be redone and resubmitted.
- The product must be completed independently.
- If the student does not complete the graduation project requirement, he or she will not be allowed to graduate.**
- If the student does not submit the Graduation Project on the announced due date, the student will lose 1 point per day for each day the portfolio is late.**
