Then, we went to see the monkeys. Some of them were swinging. Some of them were eating bananas. I thought they were funny and cute so I took photos of them.

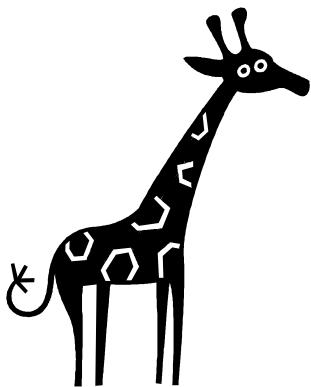
Suddenly, I found my camera was missing when I looked inside my bag. I was frightened that my mum would be very angry. I tried to stay calm and I told the zookeeper.
