Your total academic fees (i.e. one time fee, semester fee and annual fee) will be adjusted against the donation received from M/s.Bharat Forge Ltd. You are therefore, requested to confirm your willingness to accept our offer of admission at earliest by sending an E-mail on dracad@iitb.ac.in.

You will be provided sharing accommodation in student hostel as per Institute rules. Further, all students staying in hostel are required to **pay to their allotted hostel** a Mess Advance (refundable) of Rs.2,000/- plus Semester Mess Advance of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) directly to the concerned hostel at the time of joining the allotted hostel.

You are also required to pay Rs. 1000/- per year towards the cost of Bus facility within the campus. This payment is to be made to your allotted hostel to obtain "BUS PASS" for in-campus traveling.

The Institute will provide accommodation to TA category students on the campus, however, due to shortage of rooms, they may be required to continue with "sharing accommodation system".

The Institute provides accommodation on campus strictly for the duration of Programme, you have been selected for.

The Registration is scheduled on **15th & 16th July 2010 at 9:30 a.m.** in the Convocation Hall, which is followed by Orientation Programme. On collection of Registration materials, you will have to contact your Faculty Advisor in the respective Department. At the time of Registration, you are required to bring attested copies of Certificates for your Educational qualification, Birth date, Migration, Caste/Tribe/Non-Creamy Layer/Disability certificates, etc. along with originals for verification. All Teaching Assistants are required to attend a special orientation for Teaching Assistants immediately after the general orientation which is **MANDATORY**.

The Instructions for the Autumn Semester 2010-11 begins from **22nd July 2010**.

Candidates who have not yet completed their B.E./B.Tech./M.Sc. (result awaited) should bring certificate from the Head/Principal of the Institute/College about the status of their final examination. **However, they should submit their passing certificates and proof for having First class or 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in qualifying degree examination by 30th September 2010, failing which, their admissions will stand cancelled.**

The Institute reserves the right to withdraw the admission at any stage in case a candidate does not possess the requisite qualification and/or percentage of marks in qualifying degree or supplies any false information.

To utilize and maintain any motorized vehicle on the campus is strictly prohibited, excepting medical cases as required.
