## **CUA20113 Certificate II in Dance**

## (With partial completion of CUA3013 Certificate III in Dance)

**Description:** Certificate II in Dance aims to provide students with the technical and performance skills to begin the process of establishing a career in the dance industry. It enables students to develop the knowledge and skills to participate in a variety of dance routines and leads to further education and training in the performing arts industry.

Units 1 and 2 include developing basic levels of physical condition for dance performance and basic dance techniques, sourcing information on the history and theory of dance and applying it to students own area of work.

Units 3 and 4 involve students sourcing and applying entertainment industry knowledge, preparing for a dance performance, refining basic dance techniques, applying basic dance techniques for performances.

Career opportunities: Completion of Certificate II in Dance will assist students in entering the dance industry. With additional training and experience, future employment opportunities may include dancer, performer and choreographer.

RTO: 20949 Ausdance

VCE credit: Up to 4 units: two units at Units 1 and 2, and a Unit 3 and 4 sequence.

This is a scored VET.

VCAL Credit: 2 units in Year 1 and 2 units in Year 2 towards Foundation, Intermediate or Senior Certificate.

Nominal hours of the course: 440 hours over 2 years

## Outline of course structure:

To be eligible to receive the qualification, participants must successfully complete:

- Four core units in Year 1 plus two electives.
- Four core units in Year 2 plus two electives.

**Structured Workplace Learning (SWL)** is a highly recommended component of VET in Schools programs. Students are required to undertake at least 80 hours of SWL across the two year program in a suitable aligned workplace.

Participants who partially complete the qualification will be issued with Statements of Attainment for any units successfully completed.

Upon successful completion of all units, participants will be issued with a Certificate and Statement of Attainment.
