BRIEF DESCRIPTION	Annually WSC receives about 30 women and their children at the shelter for victims of sexual and domestic violence as well as provides social services, psychological and legal counseling to over 60 women annually at the center. The women and their children stay on the average 2-3 months at the shelter until employment and new lodging is found for them. The children are enrolled in kindergarten or school. The project will like to raise the annual cost for the food, infant supplies, medical needs, transportation of the victims as well as rent of the shelter.

The law on Domestic Violence is now in draft form and being evaluated. Women many times are running away from abusive and dangerous partners or mother-in-laws

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	and are left practically in the street. Often municipalities, police and increasingly from the regions call WSC to come to the assistance of these women who otherwise would be forced to return to their abusive home and be further endangered and the children traumatized.
