***Please join us on December 10<sup>th</sup> 2015 for “A Humbug Christmas!”***

Divisions 6 through 13 are very excited to present their original performance of “A Humbug Christmas” on Thursday, **December 10<sup>th</sup> 2015 at 6:30pm** in our school gym. Concerned that commercialism and trivial interests are causing people to have a “Humbug Christmas,” the grade 4 students in Division 6 will embark on a musical journey to discover the true meaning of the Holiday Season, with songs provided along the way by all our primary students.

***Please note:*** due to capacity limitations, we can only admit two audience members per family for the evening performance. We invite all other family members or additional guests to attend the dress rehearsal at **1:30pm** in the gym.

Students must arrive to the school by 6:00pm for the evening performance, and go directly to their classrooms where their teachers and/or parent volunteers will be awaiting them. Students will be on stage for the entire performance, and all students will be involved in the grand finale. As a safety precaution, we ask that adults please pick their child(ren) up from their classrooms after the concert.

Each division has been asked to wear clothing appropriate to their song. Please don't feel obligated to purchase anything, as we don't want families to be financially impacted for this event. Children have been encouraged to borrow items they may not have from family or friends. Please see the reverse of this page for your child's specific song and preferred clothing.

**Division 12 & 13 – *Little Snowflake***

(Light blue or white clothing and shoes, think as light as possible!)

**Division 11 – *Mele Kalikimaka***

(Tropical beach wear, summer clothes, flip flops, sunglasses – optional)

**Division 10 – *Getting Nuttin' for Christmas***

(Casual “cool kid” clothes - overalls, jean jackets, backwards baseball caps, sports jerseys or jackets, T shirts or “cut off” sleeves, etc.)

**Division 9 – *Christmastown***

(Elves - mostly green with a little bit of red. Again, please do not feel obligated to purchase anything, however if you do choose to buy any “elf accessories,” Dollarama has a great selection of items between \$1.00-\$2.00!)

**Division 8 – *Santa Claus is Coming to Town***

(Think “casual Christmas wear” - red or green shirts, sparkly shirts, Christmas sweaters, Christmas coloured accessories, light scarves or tuques – nothing TOO hot as they will be wearing this throughout the entire performance. Please ensure their selections are comfortable for dancing, i.e. no heels or constrictive clothing.)

**Division 7 – *When Christmas Comes to Town***

(Semi-formal – formal Christmas wear - dresses, dress pants, sparkly tops (for girls), dress shirts (boys), anything glittery, silver or gold. This group will not be dancing so small heels and dresses are ok!)

**Division 6 – *Somewhere Hovering Over Indiana***

(**Grade 3's:** Sleepwear; pj's, housecoats, slippers - so long as they can dance in them.)

(**Grade 4's:** Casual everyday clothing for acting roles, and a housecoat or sleepwear that can be quickly be put on overtop for the song.)

**\*Note:** Some grade 4's have been asked to wear more specific items, however Miss Murphy has connected with each of these students individually to make sure they know what they should have ready.
