Music [Songwriting, guitar playing, analog and digital recording, experience with rock bands (singing and playing guitar). Can read tablature, but not fluent in musical notation]

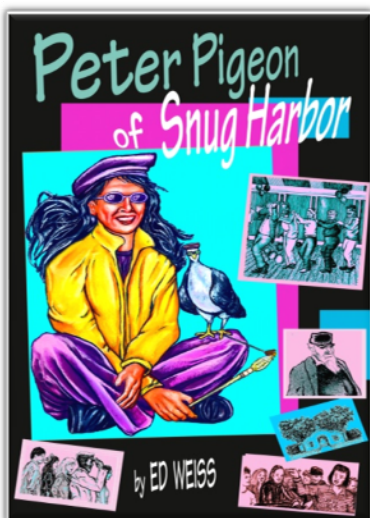
