The position requires one to cut, fit and weld pipes for marine piping systems on ships, read and interpret weld symbols or blueprints, schematics, and job specifications.

Position Requirements

Duties and Responsibilities

- Cut, fit and weld pipes for marine piping systems
- Assists pipefitters as necessary
- Responsible for checking and ensuring work areas remain safe for hot work and that fire watchers are in the correct locations.
- Assist the department supervisor on various tasks and will be a substitute for the department
- Operate a variety of power tools including, but not limited to, saws, grinders, drills, welders, and overhead cranes.

Education and Experience:

High School Diploma or Equivalent.

A minimum of 2 years' experience as a pipe welder required with at least 1 year working on US ships preferred.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities Required

- Must be able to work in a shipyard environment and is able to carry, lift, and transport heavy equipment and boxes.
- Must have thorough knowledge of TIG, MIG, SMAW, and Flux core welding fabrication.
- Must be able to pass a weld test
- Must have a valid driver's license
