

LETTER OF INTENT

ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION

1. OBJECTIVES AND FORMS OF COOPERATION

Under the terms of this letter of Technology University of Panama and National Sun Yat-sen University agree to promote the development of university education and scholarly research in areas of common interest.

Both institutions agree to the following general forms of cooperation:

- 1.1 Identification of major areas, disciplines or topics of mutual interest which could lead to exchange or joint activity;
- 1.2 Exploration of opportunities for exchange visits between members of academic, research and management staff.
- 1.3 Exploration of joint research interests between the two institutions;
- 1.4 Exploration of opportunities to support the exchange for students;
- 1.5 Exchange of research findings and publications, academic teaching resources and annual reports;

2. TERMS OF THIS LETTER

- 2.1 This letter shall commence on the signing date.
- 2.2 Each area of co-operation is to be specified in a separate Schedule. The terms and duration of each Schedule are to be independently agreed, and will be signed and dated by the partners. Any revision or modification will be in writing and by mutual agreement.
- 2.3 Either institution may, by written notice of Six (6) months, give notice to the other of its intention to terminate this letter.
- 2.4 If the letter is terminated as set out in Clause 2.3, it is agreed that any student, who at the date of termination has been accepted for an exchange program and has commenced studies at the Host institution, may complete that course of study under the terms of the letter.
- 2.5 This Letter shall be drawn up and signed in both Chinese and English. Both institutions will retain one copy each of the Letter.

The parties have mutually agreed to work together and in recognition of this they have executed this letter.
