




## Sunday Bus to Mt. Snow

Beginning in January, HVCS will offer Sunday bus transportation for select day skiing at Mt Snow.

Sit back and enjoy the ride to Mt Snow in safety and comfort. Travel from the Hudson Valley on a 55 passenger luxury motor coach chartered from Tonche Transportation of Mount Tremper.

Arrive at Mt Snow relaxed and ready to ski!

### The 7 Sunday dates in 2017 to catch the bus are:

- January 8 & 22
- February 5, 19, & 26
- March 12 & 26

### There will be 3 area pick-up spots and times:

- Bus leaves 6:00 am – Highland Park & Ride Routes 9W and 299.
- Bus leaves 6:35 am – Kingston Park & Ride Route I587 NYS Thruway Exit 19.
- Bus leaves 7:00 am – Saugerties Park & Ride, RT 32 opposite NYS Thruway Exit 20 S.

Bus will arrive at Mt Snow approximately 9:00 am. Return bus loading will begin at 3:00 pm, and departure from Mt. Snow will be at 3:30 **SHARP**.

Don't take that last run unless you want to walk home!

The bus will arrive in Saugerties approximately 5:45 pm, Kingston 6:00 pm, Highland 6:30 pm.

Pricing is very reasonable. Peak Resorts **Explorer** and **Drifter** season passholders only need to purchase bus fare. Non-pass holders can include a group lift ticket for only \$40 more.

For Hudson Valley (HVSC) and Trailsweepers (TSSC) Ski Club Members – Bus only \$38.00, Bus w/Lift \$78.00 (A valid Member Number must be supplied for each individual ticket registration and membership card shown when boarding the bus)

General Public – Bus only, \$58.00, Bus w/Lift, \$98.00.

If you are not a member want to take advantage of club member pricing, fill out a [Membership Application and Waiver and Release of Liability](#) along with a check made out to Hudson Valley Ski Club for the appropriate dues. Bring the forms and check to the bus.



Sufficient seats must be sold by 10 days before the trip date to insure the trip will proceed. In the event of a trip cancellation full refunds will promptly be issued.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the bus. Please respect other passengers' rights to a quiet and enjoyable trip.

## Climate Change - Bah Humbug!

As ski resorts grapple with the effects of climate change, from increasingly unpredictable weather to shortened seasons, "adry slopes" offer a tantalizing opportunity.

A new technology is helping ski resorts adapt to climate change. "Snowflex"- a synthetic surface, made from polymer monofilament, mimics the performance of snow and is compatible with regular ski and snowboard gear.

Liberty Mt in Virginia opened the first U.S. Snowflex slope. "You no longer have to pump snow, which eliminates a huge amount of cost and energy use", says Kevin Hoff, Liberty Mt's marketing coordinator. If heavy snow covers the synthetic surface, skiing can continue uninterrupted.

## Why Do I Ski?

A few weeks ago while visiting my parents in Florida, I was asked the following question, "Why, at your age, do you still ski?"

My first thought was what do you mean by "my age"? I then realized that the area of Florida I was in is obsessed with "age". Still the question was valid. It has taken me a while to formulate a reasonable answer.

It started with my kids wanting to ski. We kind of learned together (an adult lift ticket was \$25.00). As a beginner, falling was a constant and not much fun. Working and raising a family along with my wife (who does not ski) did not leave a lot of time or money to ski very often.

About the time my kids were in high school, my brothers-in-law started renting a ski house in Manchester, Vermont. Needless to say we skied

more often. As an intermediate skier the sport was much more enjoyable.

What really changed my attitude about the sport happened on a sunny day in February at Mt. Stratton. The death of a family member had left me in a depressed state. My brother-in-law suggested we go skiing to kind of get my mind off of the passing. I stood at the top of the headwall on Polar Bear (a black diamond) and took a deep breath. I started what might be called primal screaming, pushed off, and did not stop skiing or screaming until I reached the bottom.

For some reason my entire attitude changed. It was like a weight was lifted off my chest. So now, skiing was therapeutic.

Now I understand why I ski but the question is "Why at my age?" A very close friend of mine introduced me to

the Hudson Valley Ski Club about 10 years ago. I found an entire group of wonderful people my age (some even older) with a common interest. I found that nothing compared to the "fun" of skiing during the day and gathering in the evenings.

After taking many lessons with Herb Eschbach, Mark Searle, and Jeff Elwyn, skiing has become most enjoyable. When I am skiing nothing else really matters. I seem to be in a different world, devoid of the pressures of life.

An added benefit to all of this is being able to visit terrific ski areas around the country, enjoying the company of fellow Club members, and looking forward to yet another year.
