9:30–10:20 Play and center activities; may include:

- Writing table
- Easel
- Housekeeping
- Cooking
- Table toys
- Blocks
- Science
- Book area
- Puzzles
- Sand/water table
- Gross motor area

10:20–10:30 Clean-up, transition circle

10:30–10:40 Bathroom and washing up

10:40–11:00 Snack time

11:00–11:10 Story

11:10–11:30 Small group

11:30–11:50 Outdoor/indoor play–gross motor activities

noon Dismissal/lunch

### *Lunch Hour Plan*

12:15–12:45 Bathroom/lunch

12:45–12:55 Extended outdoor time or indoor gross motor play, puzzles, books

1:00 Dismissal for lunch only

### *Stay Day Plan*

1:00–1:30 Rest, story tapes, quiet mat activities

1:30–2:25 Story activities/enrichment program: cooking, special arts and crafts, dramatic play, music and outdoor play (weather permitting), indoor play, gross motor activities

2:30 Dismissal

### *Friday Schedule*

8:25–9:00 Early drop-off option (limited play)

9:00 Arrival: play outside (weather permitting), play inside 9:15–9:30 Welcome circle, bring out the Torah, act out the parsha story for the week, singing, etc.

9:30–10:15 Play and center activities which will include Shabbat projects (i.e., making challah)

10:15–10:30 Clean-up for Shabbat

10:30–10:45 Shabbat celebration in chapel (rabbi/cantor joins us)

10:45–11:00 Bathroom/wash-up

11:00–11:15 Shabbat helper and parent snack

11:15–11:25 Quiet book or story time

11:25–11:50 Outdoor play (weather permitting), or second play time with other options

11:50–11:50 Closing circle

11:50–noon Dismissal
