The report represents collaboration between faculty, researchers, students, administration and the team from BerryDunn. This report is now being used to begin the development of a 5 year IT strategic plan for the University, the process of which begins in late March. The first draft of the report will be presented to the University for comment and edits in early May after teams of faculty, researchers, IT staff, students and administrators complete the draft document.
