A nonfiction book contains facts and pictures about a certain topic.

Directions:

1. Use the hanger and other supplies to create a mobile. Write in complete sentences using your best handwriting and black erasable pen. Use pictures and words to describe each piece of the mobile. This book report also has the option of using a computer to type.
2. **Book Information pieces:** At the top of your mobile include a card that has the title, author, book genre and your name & number. Be sure to underline the title.
3. **Fact pieces:** Choose 7-10 objects from the book that you want to illustrate and write facts about. For example if the book was about planets you would draw and write about each planet on a separate piece. A picture of Venus would be on 1 side and 3-4 facts would be on the opposite side.
4. **Illustrations:** You may draw and color your pieces with crayons, colored pencils or markers. You may also choose to use clip art. All work should be glued onto a sturdy paper like cardstock or poster board.
5. **Hanging Instructions:** You may use string, yarn, fishing line, ribbon or other similar materials to hang your information pieces. The piece of yarn or other mentioned materials cannot be more than 12 inches long. It needs to be attached to the hanger and the information piece would be attached at the bottom of the piece of string. Spread piece apart to avoid them getting tangled.
