

REPORT OF THE SCHOOL EVENTS



Duration: 31st May 2010 to 30th June 2010

The First day of school:

The school academic session for the year 2010-2011 started on Monday the 31st of May 2010. The new academic year started with school assembly followed by a small function to welcome the students, the teaching and non teaching staff.

The welcome function was attended by Mrs. Suguna Mani (Co- founder, Chief Coordinator), Mr. Sathiaselvan.M (Director), Ms. Archana Martin (Program Manager), Teachers and the members of youth group. The function started with the lighting of the lamp followed by a welcome speech by Mrs. SugunaMani and Mr. Sathiaselvan.M

Mr. Varghese Thomas addressed the students and instructed the students to follow the rules and regulations of the school. The rules and regulations were read out for the students and teachers.

Later, a 100pg note book was given to all the students.

It was decided during the first week of the school the students will be given few topics on which they will be writing their opinion/views.

A meeting was conducted for the teachers and make shift teachers in which the program for the week was chalked out.



Celebrations at School:

On Saturday the 5th June 2010, our school celebrated world environment day. After school assembly the students lined up for a march to creative centre holding banner on environment day to create awareness among

the people about keeping the neighbourhood clean for a healthy living. The march ended at creative centre. The gathering was addressed by Mr. Sathiaseelan Martin and the starting of Horticulture Club was announced.

On 11th June 2010, the students of class IV, V and VI were given the handmade games sent by the students of TEAM 6 from Australia. The students were divided into groups of 3-4 each and were given the game along with the instructions to play. The students enjoyed playing the games and later wrote a report on the same.



School Outings

- On Saturday, the 5th June 2010, 25 students were taken for taking part in the event organized by Hotel Lalith Ashok on occasion of World Environment Day. The students were divided into 2 groups and were asked to paint on the theme world environment day. The team led by Master Rajkumar won the competition. The hotel provided snacks and lunch for all the members of SUKRUPA.
- On Sunday, the 6th of June 2010, our students took part in the drawing competition 'Nazaria' held on the occasion of World Environment Day. The selected 10 students along Mr. Mahesh Hiremat and Ms. AshaManjunath took part in the event. The competition held at Jaynagar at Rani Saralabai School. All the 10 students who took part in the drawing competition were given a sapling for growing and also got participation certificate.
- On Tuesday, the 22nd of June 2010, 52 students with 7 staff took part in the program "Lalith Green Initiative" conducted by the hotel Lalith Ashok at Bangalore University. All the members took part in the event along with the guests by planted saplings provided to them.

- On Saturday the 12th June'10, around 30 volunteers from Northern Trust led by Ms. Jane R Schreuder, President, Operations & Technology visited our school at 12pm. The group distributed shoes (blue) to the students and painted 3 rooms of our school.

Regarding School Discipline:

The teaching staff, non teaching staff and the students have to strictly follow the school timings. The reporting time is sharp 8:00am. It is instructed to all the students that they should be inside the school gate by sharp 8:00am failing to which they have to pay a penalty or consequence amount of Rs.1 per minute late.

It was decided that all the teaching staff will be in their formal dress on every Mondays. The gents will be wearing formal dress with tie while the ladies will be wearing formal sari and every Saturdays they can be in casual dress.

The students are also checked for ironing their uniform and proper hair cut. It is instructed that they will be fined for not ironing their clothes and for not having proper hair cut for only 3 days and if the student is not improving then they will be not allowed to attend the classes.

Regarding text books:

The management selected books which will be followed by the teachers and students for the academic year 2010-2011. The teacher's reference books were handed over to the respective subject teachers. Some of the reference books for the teachers of class VI, VIII and IX were not issued.

It was decided that by July the students will be given text books and note books. They will be asked to bind (Brown Cover) the same within two days. It was also decided that the students should pay Rs.1 per note book and Rs.2 per text books they receive and the amount collected will go for the student's welfare fund.

Meetings at SUKRUPA:

The teaching staff along with the make shift teachers meet every Monday at 4:00pm for a brief meeting with the management at the terrace of main school building where they discuss about the progress, functioning of school and the plan for the days to come. It was decided that from 5th July'10 the meeting will be conducted at 3:30pm to 4:00pm.

Short meeting for the teachers is conducted at the Principal chamber everyday from 3:30 to 4:00pm.

On 9th of June'10 a staff-management meeting was conducted at the terrace of the main office building from 4pm to 7pm. The agenda for the meeting was handed over to the chair and the points mentioned were discussed in the meeting. The points discussed were as under:

All the teachers and the make shift teachers attended the meeting. (The details of the above mentioned points are submitted)

Test and Exams:

- The assessment tests for the students were held from 16th June 2010 to 18th June 2010.
- Slip test and oral tests are conducted in school on regular basis.
- The date for the first round test is finalized for the 12th of July 2010. The teachers have given the test portions to the students and will be submitting the draft copies of their respective subjects to the principal by Saturday the 3rd July 2010.

The teachers and students actively participated for making the information reach to each and every individual who can't afford to bear the expense of medical treatment for almost all diseases except those related to Heart, Kidney and Brain.

The doctors specialized in Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Paediatrics, Gynaecology, ENT and General Medicine along with the paramedical staff reached the venue on time. They arranged the rooms allotted to them as per their requirements.

The camp started with lighting of lamp by the councilor Sri. Jayappa Reddy, Doctor Vaishali and the management of Sukrupa. Later Sri. Jayappa Reddy spoke about the health camp

The registration of patients were done in the main office building and were sent to the school building where the camp was held. The receptionists were allotting the room No. according to the disease/diseases the patients had. The high school students (Volunteers of SUKRUPA) were guiding the patients to the respective rooms.

Around 520 patients attended the camp and were benefitted from it.

The camp was a grand success. Many patients were given treatment in the camp itself, they were also provided with free medicines and few patients were taken to the BhagwanMahaveer Jain Hospital for the operations.

The management thanked the doctors and the volunteers who participated in the event.
