3. Maintenance Workshop-Extension
I designed extensions plan of the maintenance Workshop to accommodate a welding space and a permanent store.
4. Rehabilitation of El Mob Road House (Formerly condemned) at Lovington Green to an executive residence. The house had been left unoccupied for over five years. As a result the house had been vandalized living it in deer need of repair.
 - Replacement of all sanitary appliances.
 - Electrical rewiring and fitting all electrical appliances
 - Replacing of wooden floor parquets sanding and polishing.
 - Replacing of ceiling boards
 - Burglar proofing.
 - Painting etc
 - Reverting sewer disposal system from domestic septic tank system by connecting to public sewer system. Designed and applied for the changes approval by Nairobi City Council using my licenses.
 - Construction of permanent boundary wall and introducing a steel gate and a guard room.

In all the above I was directly involved in preparing schedule of required materials for approval by the College Management Board, Designing of the Timber traces, hiring of skilled and unskilled labour, supervising of the casuals and preparing of payment schedules.
