



## Water Main Work - *Shut Down Notice*

### Areas Affected: *All buildings located on Kitsumkalum Reserve*

In order to improve water quality, scheduled maintenance of the Kitsumkalum water lines will take place from September 16th to the 30th.

These improvements require water services to be shutdown during certain times, which will affect all houses, businesses and facilities located on reserve.

This maintenance work is taking place to ensure safe drinking water and increase the lifespan of Kitsumkalum water lines.

Portable Toilets will be available outside all main community buildings during water shut off times.

# MAINTENANCE TIPS

## Water Conservation Tips

### 1. Do not draw water into your home or turn on any taps/faucets during water shut off times. This includes:

- Bathroom sink faucet
- Tub/Shower faucets
- Kitchen sink faucet
- Dishwashers
- Washing machine

Drawing water into your home during shut off times may cause damage to your hot water tank or clog pipes within your home. Damages that occur during shut off times are the responsibility of home owners.

### 2. Shower, use and store water before or after water shut off times.

- Water shut off times are 9:00am to 4:30pm
- Prepare water storage the night before

### 3. Fill and store water in the tub and buckets before water shut off times.

- Fill the tub with water to help with flushing toilets
- Fill buckets to be used for hand washing
- Wash & sanitize buckets/containers to be used for safe drinking water

### 4. Family members/Care givers check on Elders during the day

- Check in on Elders during the day
- Assist in storing water

### 5. Only flush the toilet when needed

The toilet is not a wastepaper basket for tissues, cotton balls, or other bits of trash.

Flush the solids every single time, but alternate flushing the liquids.

The prepper's motto is 'yellow, let it mellow,' 'brown, flush it down'
