Responsibilities:

- Purchase own project pig
- Purchase wormer and/or other medication necessary for the animals health
- Purchase shavings (one bale per 5 bags of feed for up to 3-4 bales)
- Purchase feed
 - Honors Show Feed
 - Purchase 5 bags at a time when asked. Plan on up to 15 bags total.
- Clean pen once per week with the other members who have projects in the pen.
- Check project at least twice per week, one being the cleaning day.
- Assist facility owner (Kershaw Family) with completing chores while on vacation
- Complete all necessary paperwork:
 - Auction pre-registration (April 30) -- \$5 tagging fee
 - Fair Registration (July 15) – fair entrance fees
 - Intent to Sale Forms (July 15)
- Attend all required events:
 - Mandatory Auction Meeting (May 2)
 - Tagging Day (May 19)
 - GH Co. Fair
- Complete own marketing plan and promotion
- Assist with the junior 4-H member; Taylor Kershaw at home and at the fair.
- Exercise pig when needed on a daily basis 2-3 weeks prior to the fair.
- Raise a lamb as a back up project. Emily &/or Paige Kershaw have 1st rights to the pig if their steer does not make it to fair. If this happens, you will show the lamb and they will reimburse your cost into the project.
- Follow and agree with all directions provided by Christi Kershaw.

Facility Provider: _____

Responsibilities:

- Provides pen with self waterer and feeder.
- Provide heat lamp and protected cover.
- Check feed and water daily unless other arrangements have been made.
- Assist with cleaning pens
- Assist with training pigs and kids
- Oversee projects and advise with feeding, exercise, etc.

Not Responsible for:

- The health of the pig and overall care, however, will provide and assess when necessary. Remember, the facility provider is not a vet!
- The facility provider is not liable for the death and/or loss of animal. Nor are they responsible if the pig does not meet criteria to be auctioned at the fair.
