Executive Summary

The Waterloo Regional Kart Club is the largest Kart racing club in Canada and one of the largest in North America. Since moving to our new home at Flamboro Speedway in Flamborough Ontario in 2008 we have seen a dramatic increase in membership and race day entries.

Our success has been largely based by creating a fun and competitive racing environment for our members, combined with providing the best value for competitive kart racing in Ontario. Keeping karting affordable for our members is our number 1 focus.

Our club keeps our race day entries fees reasonable by running our race days almost entirely with volunteers, and through the generous support of our corporate sponsors. Providing value for our corporate sponsors has been one of the club's major goals.

Kart racing is considered the most affordable form of Motorsport, through this marketing proposal we hope to convince potential new sponsors that the WRKC is best value in Motorsport marketing.

Waterloo Regional Kart Club Fast Facts

- 2015 will be the clubs 32nd year of racing
- We have racing members from 7 to 70 years of age
- A typical race day brings approximately 250 people to the race track
- Past WRKC members have gone on to have success racing cars at racetracks all across Ontario, hence our club motto, "Where Champions are Born"
- We are the largest kart racing club in Canada

WRKC Promotional Activities In the last 12 months

- Our club website is the principal information portal for our members; we try to communicate new information to our members at least twice a month. A new re-designed and enhanced website was activated in 2014
- Our club hosts an annual karting flea market and trade show that was attended by Kart racers from all over Southern Ontario
- We are hosting a karting display at the Motorama MotorSports show in Toronto Ontario in March 2015
- We hosted a karting display at the Flamboro speedway
- The club publishes a newsletter that is handed out each race day to every racer. The primary focus of the newsletter is to promote our sponsors



WRKC Demographics and Commercial Facts

- Club events are generally attended by 200 to 250 people
- 70 % of the people at WRKC events are between 25 to 50 years of age
- A large percentage of our club members or their family members compete or participate in a car club or car racing series
- Most of our club members raise money for their racing program through corporate sponsorships. They understand the importance of supporting our club sponsors
- Over 350 people are expected to attend our annual Oktoberfest race at our home track at Flamboro Speedway
- Most of our club members are hands on participants, they work on, and prepare their own go karts
- Our youngest racer's are 7 years old and we have club members that race well into their sixties
