

STANDARD OUT OF STATE VISITATION/PHYSICAL CUSTODY SCHEDULE

(IN THE EVENT THE PARENTS RESIDE MORE THAN 150 MILES FROM EACH OTHER)

1. **Week-ends:** 1st and 3rd weekends of each month from 6:00 p.m. on Friday until 6:00 p.m. on the following Sunday. *The first Friday of a new month is deemed by this Court to be the "first weekend" of that month.* This visitation is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The visiting parent shall give the custodial parent at least five (5) days advance notice of intent to exercise visitation.
- (b) The visiting parent shall bear **all** costs of transportation attendant to the visitation;
- (c) Parents are encouraged to take into consideration the distance to be traveled, length of visitation, and duration of time between the last visitation period. Further, the parents are to ensure the safe transportation of the child and to ensure that the child is not physically and/or mentally exhausted from extensive or unreasonable travel to the detriment of the child's health, safety and well-being.
- (d) If transportation is provided by air travel, the parents shall abide by all the applicable airline rules and regulations regarding the travel for minor children. In the event airline travel can be accomplished through mean of direct flights (as opposed to connecting flights) wherein the visiting and/or custodial parent is not required to travel more than 100 miles from his/her residence to meet a flight, the flights of the children shall be direct. This is to reduce the risk of diverted, cancelled or delayed flights, thereby increasing their stress in such travel.

2. **Spring Break/Fall Break:** From 9:00 a.m. on the first Saturday following the last day of school (recognized by the district in which the child resides or, if the child attends school, recognized by the school district in which the child is enrolled) until 6:00 p.m. on Sunday at the end of Spring Vacation in *odd*-numbered years; the same schedule will be following in *even*-numbered years for the Fall break period. If either or both of these time periods exceeds 10 days or more (inclusive of weekends), then the visitation period will be for the first half of the respective time period. These periods of visitation supersede the weekend visitation rights. This visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in subparagraphs 1(a) through 1(d) above.

3. **Summer:** From 6:00 p.m. on June 15th until 6:00 p.m. on July 15th each year. The parents shall share equally in the reasonable costs of transportation connected with the exercise of this visitation as follows: The non-custodial parent shall cause the child to be delivered to the non-custodial parent's residence no later than 6:00 p.m. on June 15th; and the custodial parent shall cause the child to be delivered back to his or her residence no later than 6:00 p.m. on July 15th at the end of such visitation.

4. **Easter:** On Easter weekend from Friday before Easter at 6:00 p.m. until Easter Sunday at 6:00 p.m. in each *odd*-numbered year, such to supersede weekend visitation. This visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in subparagraphs 1(a) through 1(d) above.

5. **Thanksgiving:** From 6:00 p.m. on the day school is recessed for said holiday until 6:00 p.m. on the Sunday following in *odd*-numbered years. The Thanksgiving visitation supersedes the weekend and weekday visitation rights. This visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in the subparagraphs 1(a) through 1(d) above.

6. **Christmas:** In *even*-numbered years, from 9:00 a.m. on December 20th until 6:00 p.m. on December 26th; and, in *odd*-numbered years, from 6:00 a.m. on December 26th until 6:00 p.m. on January 2nd next following. The Christmas visitation supersedes the weekend and weekday visitation rights. The parents shall share equally in the reasonable costs of transportation connected with the exercise of this visitation as follows:

The non-custodial parent shall cause the child to be delivered to his or her residence no later than the appointed time; and

The custodial parent shall cause the child to be delivered back to his or her residence no later than the appointed time at the end of such visitation.

7. **Child's Birthday:** On the child's birthday from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. This visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in subparagraphs 1(a) through (d) above. If the non-custodial parent is exercising visitation with the child on the child's birthday pursuant to other provisions herein, then the custodial parent shall visitation with the child from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on the child's birthday. The visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in subparagraphs 1(a) through (d) above. It is the Court's intention that both parents have an opportunity to be with the child on the child's birthday.

8. **Weekend of Father's Day:** The Father shall exercise visitation from Friday at 6:00 p.m. until Sunday at 6:00 p.m., regardless of whether such conflicts with other provisions. This visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in subparagraphs 1(a) through (d) above.

9. **Mother's Day:** The Mother shall have visitation from Friday at 6:00 p.m. until Sunday at 6:00 p.m., regardless of whether such conflicts with other provisions. This visitation shall be subject to the conditions set forth in subparagraphs 1(a) through (d) above.

10. **Holidays Falling on a Monday After a Visitation:** If the Monday after a weekend or holiday weekend (Easter/Thanksgiving/Father's Day/Mother's Day) of visitation is a school holiday for the child, the visitation period shall extend until 6:00 p.m. on that Monday.

11. The custodial parent shall be entitled to the same holiday and special occasion periods (Christmas/Thanksgiving/Easter/School Spring/Fall Vacation) with the child in the years opposite those years designated for visitation with the non-custodial parent, regardless of whether it conflicts with the weekend periods of visitation herein awarded to the non-custodial parent. The special occasion and holiday visitations take precedence over the weekend visitation awarded herein.
