It's time for spring cleanup!

Menahga Municipal Code IX.92 requires all properties within city limits to maintain an environment that is a clean and provides for a safe place to work and live. The language can be found on our website: www.cityofmenahga.com.

Property owners please be mindful that this maintenance includes but is not limited to, pet waste, unlicensed vehicles, household garbage, or building materials.

When a complaint is received regarding possible violations, the property owner will be issued a warning letter requesting the owner address the problem within a specific period of time. If the problem is not corrected, a citation will be issued in accordance with the specific code violation.

A violation can result in a fine up to \$300. If the City is forced to correct the issue, the property owner will be billed for the cleanup. The costs may also be assessed to the property owner's taxes.
