Thank you for your interest in being a Boston College Club Sport coach. You will be involved with a very special group of student-athletes. These student-athletes not only train hard physically, but, since all Club Sports are student-run organizations, they must organize all aspects of their club's activities.

The role of a Club Sports Coach is to act as a positive role model for the club's members and to assist in the instructional and coaching elements of a club's activity. Boston College Club Sports are student-run organizations. Under the direction of the Assistant Director of Club Sports & Recreational Camp and the club's individual advisor (a full-time Boston College faculty or staff person), club officers are responsible for making all decisions regarding the operation of the club (including, but not limited to, all financial paperwork, purchases, prospective player inquiries, space request, etc). Club Sport Coaches are considered Boston College employees and are held to the University code of conduct. Please note that hazing and alcohol-related activities at club sport events are strictly prohibited, and by serving as a positive role model, it is expected that coaches will enforce this policy and report any alcohol and/or hazing activities to the Assistant Director of Club Sports & Recreational Camp.
