#### **RESPECT SELF**

- **Dress appropriately following all District and school policies**
- **Be in seat before bell rings**
- **Prepared for class with all materials everyday**
  - pen/pencil, notebook, textbook, any additional items directed by teacher
- **Use class time efficiently**
  - Participate in all class discussions & assignments
  - Use appropriate, positive school language

#### **RESPECT OTHERS**

- **Show respect toward teachers, staff and substitute teachers at all times**
  - Accept other people's opinions
  - Use appropriate, positive school language
- **Keep hands, feet and objects to self**
- **Use appropriate voice and raise hand for questions, comments or to ask for permission to leave the classroom or move about the room**
- **Electronic devices and accessories including headphones are kept out of sight in the classroom and hallways**

#### **RESPECT PROPERTY**

- **Be considerate of school property and other people's property**
- **Coats, backpacks, large purses and bags are not permitted in classrooms**
- **Be neat—put garbage in cans, return books and other items to the proper place, take belongings with you**
- **Food and drink remains in designated areas-- Classroom teachers will notify students in advance if food or drink is permitted the next school day**
- **Respect school-owned and teacher-owned property—repair or clean items when necessary. Classroom desks remain in current position unless approval granted from teacher**
- **Respect property in all public areas including hallway lockers and PE lockers**

- **Additional Expectations:**

- **Students are to be quiet when the bell rings, or a 10 minute detention can be given.**
- **Cheating (talking during quiz/test, writing information on desks or other objects, looking at another person's paper, text messaging, etc.) can result in a significant grade reduction, a phone call home, and a possible referral to the assistant principal.**
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- **Possible Consequences:**
- **Verbal warning, phone call/email home, classroom detention, referral to assistant principal**
