◇ Sales Summary

In February, compared with the previous year, which was a leap year, one less day caused negative results.
 Sales of sports shoes and kids shoes continued to be strong.
 All stores sales declined by 1.9% to a year ago in this month.
 Existing stores sales also showed contracted by 3.0% compared to the same period in the previous year.

As a result, all stores sales grew 3.1% and existing stores sales also grew 0.9% a year on year.
