**NEED HELP PREPARING YOUR TAXES?**

It's that time again. The AARP Tax Preparation Team will start preparing taxes beginning February 2016 through April 2016. Appointments will be 9am-11am. Please make an appointment to have your 2015 Federal and State tax prepared by signing up at the front desk or by calling the Senior Center at (408) 783-1284.

This service is free, and you do not have to be a member of AARP. Bring your 2014 tax return, the white envelope containing your 2014 tax return, your social security card (or social security statement-Form SSA-1099), your driver's license, your property tax statements, if you are going to itemize deductions, and most importantly bring your Spouse, as both will have to sign the tax return. If you are under 65 and not covered by Medicare, proof of medical coverage under the Affordable Care Act (Obama Care).

Your Fed and CA tax returns will be prepared by our IRS-certified 7 person staff at the Centennial Recreation Senior Center, 171 W. Edmundson Ave.

**Hearing Screenings and Hearing Aid Cleaning:**


