THE EQUIPMENT BORROWING CONDITIONS

1. The equipment is to be returned in the same condition as received, presumably clean, undamaged and in good working order. Damaged or faulty goods must be returned immediately to the Coordinator, AIS Sports Nutrition Discipline.
2. The user shall cover the full replacement or repair cost if the equipment is lost, stolen or damaged (total cost \$570 inclusive of GST and freight charges). Certain dispensation in the expected replacement charges may be given if the equipment is damaged in the course of "normal operations." The reduction in charges is specific to each piece of equipment and will be dependent on the age of the item(s) in question.
3. The user will return the equipment on the agreed date. "Equipment return" is defined as the packaging, insurance and transportation of the equipment to the Sports Nutrition Discipline at the AIS. These will be arranged and paid by the user.
4. Only those persons listed on this form are to operate borrowed equipment.
5. Equipment loaned must be kept in a secure location whilst not in use.
6. Equipment to be returned includes the Horiba LAQUAtwin Na+ analyser, standard solutions, batteries and, steel forceps. All other consumables must not be returned and can be kept by the user or discarded.
