



Kenosha Unified School District Equipment Loan Agreement



A tablet computer used in the auto class taught by a Gateway Technical College (GTC) instructor will be allowed to go home under the following conditions:

1. This computer loan agreement is signed by both student and parent and returned to the student's GTC instructor. It will be kept on file at the Educational Support Center Career and Technical Education Office.
2. Use of this equipment for any purpose other than educational use may result in loss of tablet computer privileges.
3. This district does not permit students to use the Internet or e-mail for personal purposes on computers loaned by the school. Violation of this policy may result in the loss of tablet computer loan privileges and disciplinary action by the school.
4. The configuration of the hardware equipment and all accompanying software may not be altered, nor can software be copied to or from the computer or installed on the computer under any circumstances.
5. Parents/guardians accept full financial responsibility for any loss or theft of the equipment while it is in the student's possession. The cost of the repair or replacement of this equipment caused by neglect, careless handling or improper care is also the parent/guardian's responsibility. Failure to pay such costs will result in implementation of the Kenosha Unified School District's collection procedures. **The replacement cost for this tablet computer is \$1,525.00. The replacement cost for the charger only is \$20.00. The replacement cost for the stylus only is \$10.00.**
6. Students must bring the tablet computer that has been loaned for their auto class(es) to class each day. Failure to bring the computer each day will result in the loss of the computer privileges. The tablet computer, which is the property of Kenosha Unified School District, must be *returned to the Gateway instructor prior* to the end of the completion of the class *in the condition it was given*.

FOB (electronic key): The student will need access to specific areas at the Horizon Center that require a use of a fob. KUSD has purchased these fob's for you to use during your classes at Gateway Technical College's Horizon Center for Transportation Technology. You are responsible for returning your fob to your Gateway Technical College instructor on the last day of class. **If you do not return the fob, you will be billed responsible for replacing it. The cost of a replacement fob is \$10.00** This is an electronic entry system that is monitored. You will be responsible for the equipment in the area that you access.

TEXTBOOK: KUSD has also purchased textbooks for the student to use while in the classes. The student is not allowed to write or mark in the book. If a student does not return the textbook at the end of the class(es) in the condition that it was checked out in, the student will be responsible for replacing the book. **The replacement cost for the textbook is \$150.00.**

We, the undersigned student and parent, agree to assume full responsibility for the proper care and educational use of the computer equipment and fob described in this document.
