8. The process of registration will commence at the South Asian University, Akbar Bhawan, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi from **Monday, July 22, 2013**. You are required to present yourself **in person** for completing registration/admission formalities on any day between July 22 to July 25, 2013. In exceptional cases, registration with late fee of US \$ 10 (INR 550/-) would be permitted up to August 14, 2013. Extension for registration beyond August 14, 2013, will NOT be permitted under any circumstances. Therefore, candidates are advised NOT **to come to the University for Admission after August 14, 2013**.
9. Location map of SAU is available on University website.
10. If you need a VISA to enter India for studies at SAU, you are advised to immediately approach the Indian Embassy/High Commission in your country along with a copy of this offer letter, and apply for SAU Student VISA. The SAU VISA is a special category Visa especially instituted by the Government of India for overseas students admitted to SAU.
11. The list of documents that you MUST bring along with you is enclosed (Annexure-2). **You are strongly cautioned not to come to SAU unless you have all originals of your qualifying degree certificates/mark sheets/transcripts, on the basis of which, you have been offered admission to this course.**
12. The University has the provision of providing a limited number of Government of India's Silver Jubilee Scholarships (SJS) to students from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives and Nepal, if they come from economically weaker families and cannot afford to pay their fees. In addition, financial aid at different levels is also available for students from economically weaker families from all SAARC countries. A separate application will have to be submitted for availing SJS or SAU financial aid after you join the University. Details of Scholarships and financial aid are available at SAU admission webpage. If you wish to apply for SJS/financial aid, please bring along proofs of your family income (salary slips of your parents/bank statements, copies of income tax returns, Income Certificate issued by the designated competent authority, etc.). These documents will be necessary to consider your application for grant of SJS/financial aid. Disbursal of SJS and the financial aid will require that the student maintains a minimum of 75% attendance in classes, satisfactory academic performance and good conduct. Regular attendance and presence of the awardee in the university would be compulsory throughout the course and no part-time/full-time work outside the University will be permitted.
13. Hostel accommodation (on shared basis) will be available only to students from outside Delhi and National Capital Region (NCR) for the duration of Monsoon Semester and Winter Semester expressly defined as the periods from July 20 to Dec 15 and Jan 5 to May 31 respectively for this purpose. No accommodation will be provided for spouse and family members of the students. Students will be expected to vacate the hostels during summer and winter vacations.
14. **Mess is compulsory for all Hostellers.** Mess charges are likely to be around US\$ 80 (Indian Rupees 4400/-) per month and will have to be paid in advance for each month.
