Ardrossan Roads Upgrade

Third Avenue and Queen Street



Project update

We would like to inform you that construction work on Third Avenue and Queen Street is scheduled to begin late July 2016. The Ardrossan roads upgrade is a priority within the Ardrossan Area Structure Plan. Strathcona County has contracted WRD Borger Construction Ltd. for construction.



What's being improved

The roadway improvements will improve safety and support safe, sustainable growth. Improvements include:

- roadway reconstruction
- intersection improvements
- 250 metres of sidewalks with curb and gutters installed
- street lighting upgrades
- overhead power lines relocated to underground
- underground improvements to water, sanitary and storm sewer systems.



Project activities begin late July

- Construction on Queen Street from Range Road 221A to Third Avenue
- Construction on Third Avenue from Queen Street to Main Street
- Project completed by September 2016, weather permitting.



Temporary disruptions

Affected residents will be notified by the contractor if a temporary service disruption to power or water is required to complete upgrades on the power line or water, sanitary and storm sewer systems.

Household waste removal services will continue as usual; however, the contractor may relocate garbage bins for affected residents outside of the construction zone for easier collection, and will then return the bins.



Road closures and detours

Remember to stay alert and slow down in construction zones. There are roadway closures required for this project. Please heed all project signage.
