Welcome to our newsletter. Our aim in producing this occasional newsletter is to keep you informed about the progress of the project and what you can expect to see happening on and around the site in the weeks to come.

What We're Building

This project will involve the removal of trees and relocation of material excavated from the existing ground to provide a levelled area, installation of new drainage and retaining walls to allow the formation of the new car park and campus building. Demolition works will also take place at the Parkside Primary School to allow a new access road to be formed and new access routes around the building will be created.

The new facility will serve 2 to 18 year olds as well as providing further education opportunities and community facilities for the town.

Jedburgh intergenerational community campus will replace Jedburgh Grammar, Howdenburn and Parkside primary schools, and will be located on land at Hartrigge Park.

The campus will have provision for nursery, primary and secondary school children, and facilities would include a multi-use games area, 2G hockey pitch, 3G sports pitch, running track, external changing pavilion and rural skills area

Works are scheduled for completion in August 2020

Initial Works

Site establishment, fencing and hoarding

Clearing land of obstructions and protecting trees that will remain.

Utility services / drainage diversion

Partial demolition of Parkside Primary School

Formation of access roads

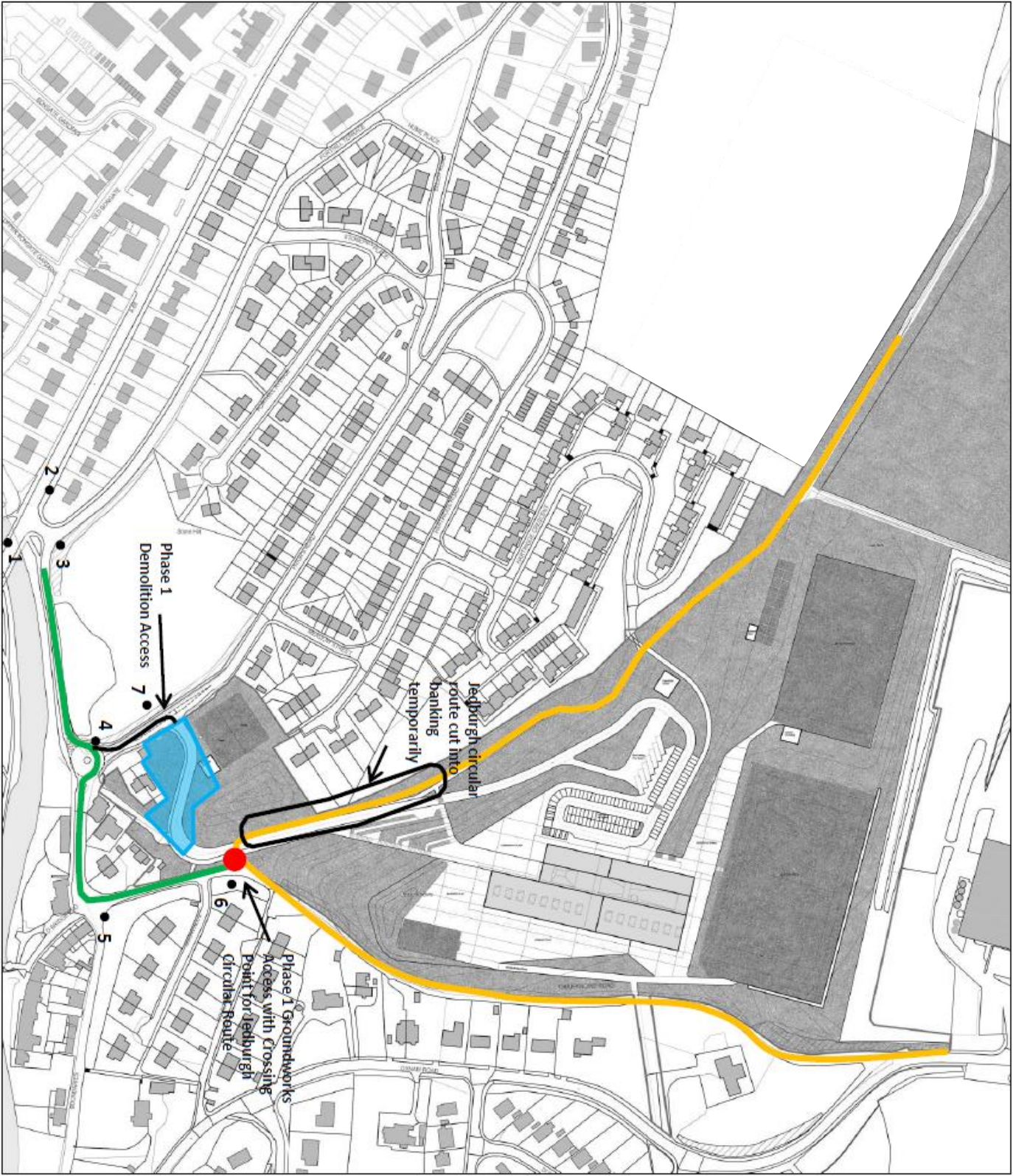

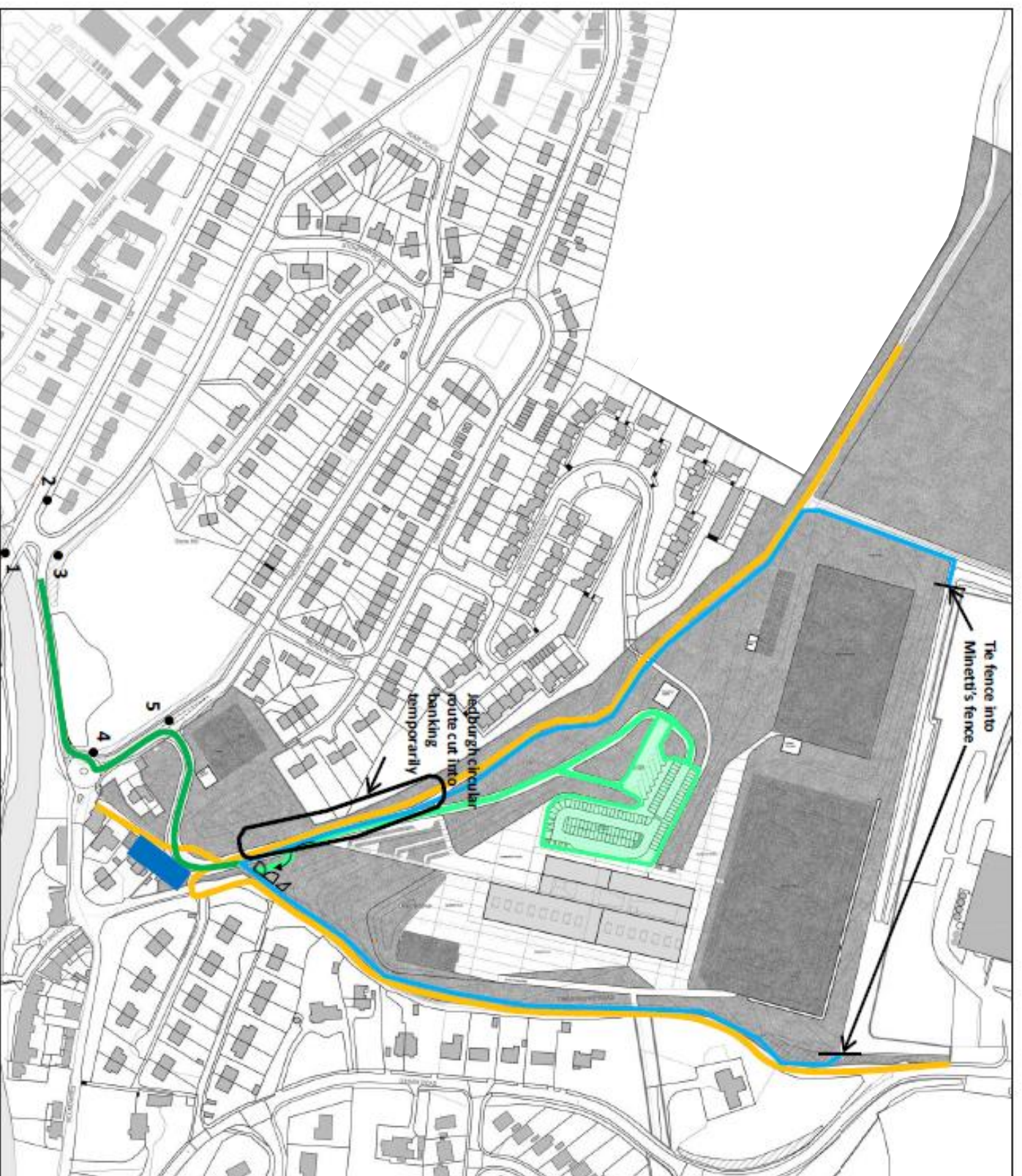
