

# Acceptance Agreement

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Students who accept our offer of admission agree to the following conditions:

1. A deposit of \$475\* is required by the deposit deadline of your selected admission plan to reserve a space in our entering class. If applying early decision, submitting a deposit for Early Decision I or Early Decision II serves as confirmation that: (1) If you applied for financial aid, you have received your package, and on that basis you are depositing; (2) You will withdraw any outstanding admission applications to other schools, including Emory College of Emory University.
2. Admitted students have a continuing obligation to inform the Office of Enrollment Services of any changes in the information provided on their admission application that could affect their status as an admitted student, including, but not limited to changes in their academic record, criminal convictions, suspension from school, and other requested information.
3. All students are required to live on campus, unless granted commuter status by Residential Education and Services. To have your housing assignment preferences considered, students must complete a housing registration form by June 1. Students wishing to commute also must complete a housing registration form no later than June 1. All students living in college housing are required to participate in the full Oxford College meal plan.
4. A final transcript must be sent from the high school after graduation or from any college attended. This transcript must be on file before registration for classes. **Please note: Acceptance is granted on condition that applicants continue to maintain the same level of scholarship in high school as at the time of acceptance. If the academic record for the current year is not satisfactory, the Admission Committee will review the file again and notify the student if the acceptance status changes.**
5. All high school applicants who have previously enrolled in or are currently enrolled in college or university courses must request a transcript of credits from each college attended. The transcript should be sent from the college or university to Emory University, Office of Admission–Undergraduate, 3263-001-1AA, 1390 Oxford Road NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30322-1016.
6. For students to receive credit at Oxford for attending another institution in the summer or for special work after acceptance, prior permission from Oxford College must be obtained.
7. In accepting Oxford's offer of admission, students agree that while enrolled they will abide by all rules, regulations, practices, and conduct and honor policies set by the college, that are in effect at the time of admission or that may change during the course of enrollment. Students agree to pay fines or assessments that may be incurred from the library or for violation of campus traffic or safety rules (including parking rules) and agree that such charges can be added to tuition and fee statements.
8. In order to receive services from Emory University, a student must self-identify as having a disability. Please contact the Office of Disability Services at 404.727.6016 (voice); 404.712.2049 (TTY) for more information.
