


# Collin College issues second report card


The Collin College Board of Trustees is dedicated to continuous improvement to ensure the finest education for our students.






**Course Completion Rates**  
Collin vs. State Average




**Number of Professionals Certified**  
Five Year Period





**Administrative Costs**
