

CONTRACT AWARD – FIVE TOWNS PARK DEVELOPMENT

The Civil Engineering Division is pleased to announce the contract award of the Five Towns Park Development in Castleford for new client GMI Construction.

Five Towns Park is a major new development project adjacent to Junction 32 of the M62 by the Lateral Property Group in partnership with GMI Construction. The overall development includes a new 10,000 person capacity stadium for the Castleford Tigers Rugby League team, a country park, petrol station with food store, retail park and major highways improvements.

I & H Brown are delivering the highways improvements to support the whole Five Towns Park Development. Our scope includes the upgrade of the major roundabout leading off junction 32 of the M62 including installation of a new access to the development site, street lighting, traffic signals, service diversions and the resurfacing of the slipways on and off of the M62. In addition, we have two smaller road schemes within our package on the roads surrounding the development site; the upgrade of Parkland roundabout and installation of a new access to the west of the site from Spittal Hardwick Lane.

The project will begin on site in September this year and will take 58 weeks.
