

Training Development Timeline Estimation

The mainstay of the study covered various development tools and the levels of interactivity based on the ADDIE model. The study did not include time estimates for summative evaluation, only formative. Estimates do not include the analysis part of the process, which can take approximately between 40 and 120 hours depending on SME and ID availability.

Please note that there were some clear trends in the qualitative responses indicating three main issues impacting the time to develop instruction and they primarily stem from the client; scope of work, technology, and review time.

Content readiness, process and software stability, SME availability and review cycles drive development time and overall schedule.
