## **INSTRUCTIONS**

**STEP 1**      Using the scale below, read the following inventory, and put either a 3, 2, 1, or 0 beside each statement to indicate how true it is of your own life.

3 = True all of the time  
2 = True much of the time  
1 = True some of the time  
0 = Never true at all

It is important that you answer every question according to who you are now, not who you would prefer to be or think you ought to be. The test will be as reliable as you are honest in your answers.
