

GRADE 7 ORAL BIOGRAPHY REPORT

The 7th grade oral biography book report will be presented February 27 through March 2 in the classroom. Each student should pick a biography and sign the biography sheet in the classroom with the title and author of the book. The week before the report student names will be drawn for the day the report will be given and the order on that day.

After reading the book, the student should decide the costume he/she will wear. He/She can decide to talk about the main character or be the main character and use “I” in the speech. The student should prepare the speech and mention the characters in the book, give the title of the book and the author, tell the story of the person that the book is about, and explain why the person is famous. This is NOT a written report; it is an ORAL report. A student may use note cards to give the oral report, but not big sheets of paper.

The oral part of the report will be judged on the eye contact, voice volume, enunciation, and stance (how a person stands in front of the audience). The costume will be judged on appropriateness and creativity.

The time limit is 4 minutes.
