



PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT STREET MAINTENANCE NOTICE

Dear Irvine Resident:

The City of Irvine Public Works Department is pleased to announce that it will be conducting its annual Street Rehabilitation and Slurry Seal Project in your neighborhood this year. The City has contracted with All American Asphalt to perform the necessary construction activities, including asphalt paving operations scheduled for the communities of College Park and The Colony.

Every effort will be made to complete this essential work quickly and with as little inconvenience to your residence and community as possible. Your assistance and cooperation during this project will be greatly appreciated.

Construction Process

All public streets within your community will be resurfaced with new asphalt (see map). The process will take approximately 3-4 days to complete for each individual street.

- Construction:** Resurfacing operations are scheduled to begin **August 3, 2015**, and will continue until all public streets have been completed. Estimated completion date is September.
- Work Hours:** Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Access:** Access may be delayed or restricted at times. Alternate routes or detours will be made available, when possible.
- Notification:** “No Parking” signs will be posted at designated locations 72 hours prior to work commencing on any street. Please observe these notices as **vehicles parked on a street with a posted “No Parking” sign will be towed.** On-street parking will only be restricted on the dates and times specified on the “No Parking” signs.

Parking: Please refer to the temporary “No Parking” signs that will be posted in the affected areas during days of scheduled work. Alternate parking is allowed in other areas that do not have “No Parking” signs posted.

Access to residential driveways may be restricted during asphalt paving operations. This is when the street is closed to allow for the placement of new pavement. Cars should be parked outside the paving boundaries during this time.

Trash Pick-up: Regular trash pick-up services will not be disrupted during construction. The contractor will coordinate all activities with Waste Management and will ensure trash pick-up to occur on your normal service day.

Please be aware that **schedules may be subject to change** due to weather conditions or other unforeseen factors. If construction work does not occur on the posted date, the work will be rescheduled and new signs will be posted with new dates.
