- 1) Title, Author, and Story Building card of your book
- 2) Picture(s) and paragraph (5 sentences) describing the setting of your book
- 3) Picture(s) and paragraph (5 sentences) describing the main characters of your book
- 4) Plot timeline: Use at least 4 pictures (each with a sentence or two near the picture) describing the main parts of the plot (what happens in the story)
- 5) Personal Review: write a paragraph (5 sentences) explaining what you liked, did not like, favorite part, things you might have changed in the story, and whether or not you would recommend the book to friends

All written parts must be typed or neatly written in blue or black ink. Pictures may be hand drawn or printed from the Internet.
