BRIEFING FOR BAPTISM OF BABIES will be conducted in English on Sunday, **24th March** immediately after the 3rd Mass in the Cathedral. Parents and Godparents **MUST** attend this briefing. Documents to bring for the briefing are as follows:-

According to Canon Law # 874, a Sponsor (God parent) must be a baptised, confirmed and practising Catholic. If married, his/her marriage must already be blessed in the Catholic Church.

MASS OFFERING - Parishioners may offer mass for a private intention e.g. thanksgiving, any special prayer request or repose of soul for a departed loved one, by filling out a Mass Offering Form available at the Parish Office. Any request for a mass to be said for your prayer intention on a 'specified' date must be submitted to the Parish Office one month in advance. Otherwise, your prayer intentions will be offered up at any time (at the discretion of our priests).

MARRIAGE CONVALIDATION COURSE in Bahasa Malaysia will be organised by the Cathedral Faith Formation team for couples who are civilly married for more than 5 years (*registered at Jabatan Pendaftaran Negara or via Adat Istiadat*) but whose marriage have not been blessed in the Catholic Church. Both spouses must be in their first marriage and at least one party is a Catholic. This course will be conducted on **23rd & 24th March** (Saturday & Sunday), from 8:30 am till 4:30 pm at the A.C.C.P.C.. Registration fee is RM110 per couple. Please register with the Parish Office by Monday, **18th March**. The Marriage Convalidation Mass (Marriage Blessing) will be held at a later date in the Cathedral.
