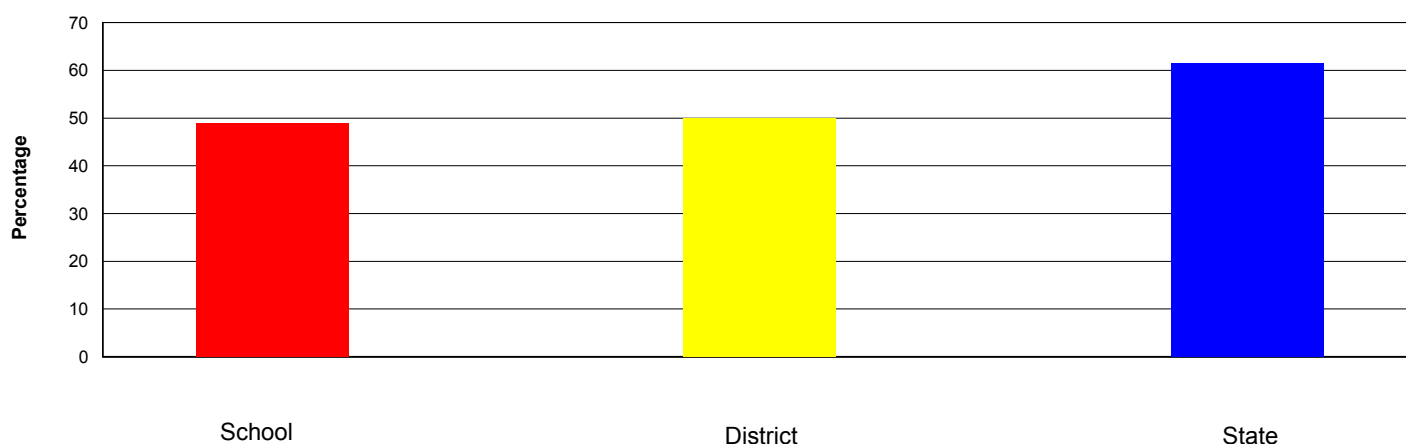

College Going Rates for this Year's Graduating Class



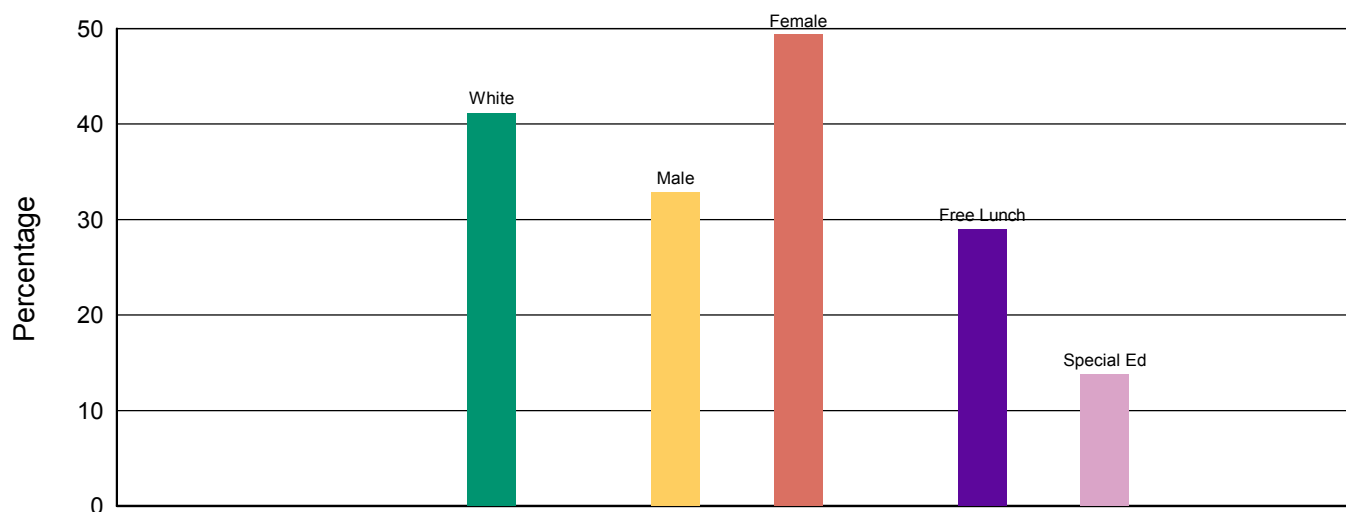

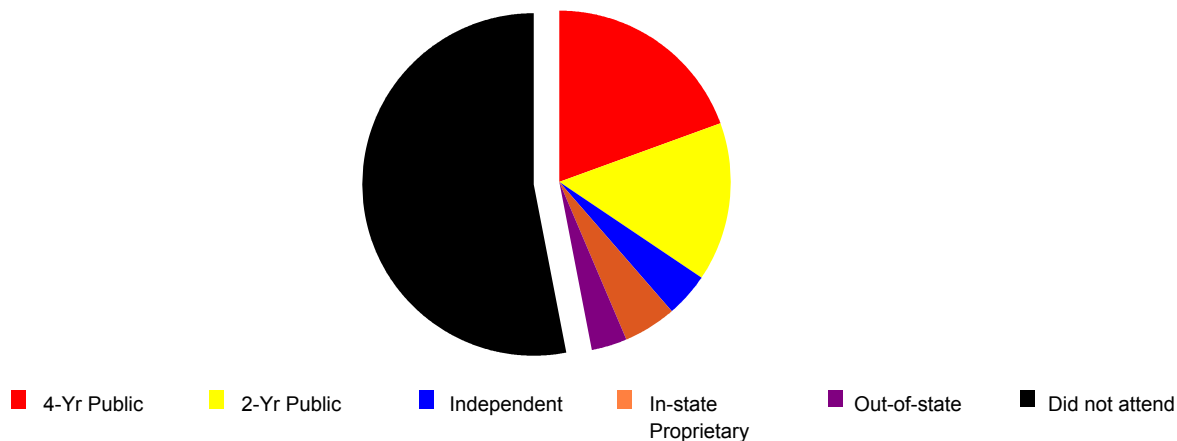

College Going Rates for Graduates by Demographic Characteristics

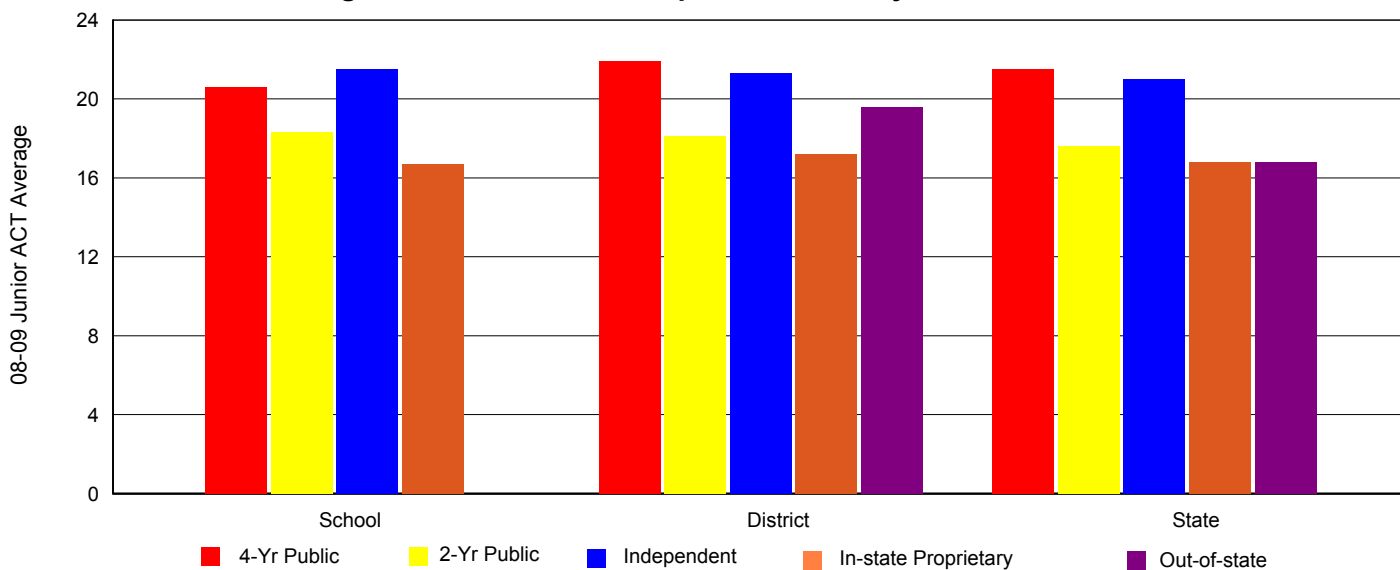
