# 1 Introduction

## 1.1 Purpose

If you have seen the Table of Contents, you'll know that this booklet is intended for people of all faiths. As a disclaimer, I'm a traditional prayer-book<sup>1</sup> Anglican, but I've tried to be objective.

This document was written to help those interested in finding a faith community that would be appropriate for them. Also, there may be people who simply want to learn more about the religious life of St. John's and the surrounding area. I have tried to be inclusive, addressing not only all Christian denominations, but also other religions. For brevity, I have used the word *church* to mean (unless the context implies otherwise) a church or other place of worship.

## 1.2 How to Use This Booklet

If you are reading this as a pdf file, you will see that the Table of Contents is linked electronically to the sections of the document. There are five principal denominations in this area: the *Anglican Church of Canada*, the *Pentecostal Assemblies of Newfoundland and Labrador*, the *Roman Catholic Church*, the *Salvation Army*, and the *United Church of Canada*. There is a section for each, plus another section for all other Christian churches, and finally a section for all other places of worship. If you don't see what you are looking for in the Table of Contents, then try the Index at

the back of the book. It is easy to say whether or not a church belongs to one of the five principal denominations. Faith communities which are not part of these five denominations but which are clearly Christian have been placed in the "Other Christian Churches" section. All other faith communities have been placed in the "Other Places of Worship" section.

## 1.3 What's In, and What's Out

I have included every church in or near St. John's of which I am aware. If I have omitted anything, please advise me by email (see below). This document is meant to be primarily a living resource rather than an historical archive. However, the final section of the document does provide information about the major changes that have occurred since the first edition of this document (6 August 2010).

For each church I have given (if applicable) contact information such as location, mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, email address, and website address. In most cases, churches are in their own buildings, but in some cases they are simply renting a room in a building somewhere. I have provided information for both situations, but only provide photographs for buildings primarily used for religious purposes. I have not given the names of clergy, nor the times of services.

A church's website address should be a good place to look for service times, plus other information not provided here, but many churches do

<sup>1</sup>The Anglican Church of Canada uses both the *Book of Common Prayer* (1962) and the *Book of Alternative Services* (1985). The former uses traditional language, and the latter uses contemporary language. Here is an example:

***Te Deum*** (BCP, page 7)

We praise thee O God; we acknowledge thee to be the Lord.  
All the earth doth worship thee, the Father everlasting.

***You are God*** (BAS, page 94)

You are God: we praise you; you are the Lord: we acclaim you;  
you are the eternal Father: all creation worships you.

## 9 Major Changes

Major changes would include churches which have opened or closed, or churches which have changed their name or denominational affiliation. Changes in location are included only if it involves a permanent building (going from, going to, or both), rather than simply going from one rented space to another. The date which is indicated refers to the date of publication of this document when the change was noted, rather than the date on which the change itself took place.

### 9.1 2010

1. The closure of the New Life Fellowship (Southern Baptist) was noted on 29 October 2010.
2. The closure of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship was noted on 1 November 2010.
3. The Church of St. Michael and All Angels (Anglican) left its downtown building; this was noted on 16 December 2010. For several years they worshipped at Carnell's Funeral Home, and in April 2014 they moved to 75 Kiwanis Street.

### 9.2 2011

No major changes.

### 9.3 2012

1. The congregation of Trinity United Church in Mount Pearl amalgamated with First United Church (page 19); the separate entry for Trinity United Church was delisted on 28 February 2012.
2. There is a new building in Paradise for the Jehovah's Witnesses (noted on 16 May

2012), replacing the building located in Mount Pearl.

3. A new non-denominational congregation, the Emmanuel Chinese Church, has been formed and is worshipping at St. Augustine's Anglican Church (noted on 16 May 2012).
4. There is a new church in Torbay called the Torbay Family Church (PAONL) (noted on 9 July 2012).

### 9.4 2013

1. The Avalon Wesleyan Church closed in April 2013; its members joined the Solid Rock Wesleyan Church.

### 9.5 2014

1. Moravian services in St. John's have ended; the listing was deleted in April 2014.
2. The Lighthouse of Hope (United Pentecostal Church) has closed; the listing was deleted in April 2014.
3. The new building for St. Michael and All Angels opened on Maundy Thursday, 17 April 2014.

### 9.6 2015

1. The Mosaic University Chapel (PAONL) appears to have ceased operations. Its entry was deleted in May, 2015.
2. The Torbay Family Church (PAONL) announced that services were being suspended in August, 2015. Its website went dark in October; the entry has been deleted.



## 9.7 2016

No major changes.

## 9.8 2017

1. *Christian Missionary Fellowship International* was added in August, 2017.
2. Vineyard Fellowship closed December, 2017.

## 9.9 2018

1. In January the CBC reported a new PAONL initiative called *Local Church*.
2. In April, 2018 Calvary Baptist sold its building on Kenmount Road. They are worshipping at the Seventh-day Adventist Church on Aldershot Street while they consider constructing a new building in Paradise.
3. *True Life Church* was added in June, 2018.
