



Behavior Management Plan

For Pre-K

1. Listen and follow all directions.
2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
3. Be respectful.
4. Use your inside voice.
5. Clean up and organize.

Positive Reinforcements:

Students will have an opportunity to receive a reward for good behavior everyday day. The reward will vary from day to day. Daily rewards will consist of affirmations, verbal cheers, prizes, positive notes home, positive phone calls, positive reinforcement, stickers, and compliments. You will see the excellent or good day highlighted on folder if your child has made good choices throughout the day.

Discipline System:

GREEN	The student had a good day and did his work
Consequence #1	The student will receive 2 verbal warnings. (Might be skipped depending on behavior)
Consequence #2	After 2 nd warning, the child will be ask to sit on a different space to settle down and will be able to return to the group as he feels ready to behave properly.
Consequence #3 YELLOW	Child will lose privileges such as recess or center time.
Consequence #4 RED	When a child's behavior puts himself or others in danger, the office will be contacted.
