

## Statement of Faith

As part of the application to the BA in Intercultural Studies, all students are asked to complete a statement of faith which includes agreement with Dallas Int'l's doctrinal statement, a covenant to comply with the Dallas Int'l code of conduct and a personal testimony of relationship with Jesus Christ. ### DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

6. Justification is by faith alone.
7. The Holy Spirit's power is demonstrated in and through Christians.
8. The body will be resurrected, both in the case of the just and of the unjust.
9. Humanity's final state is the eternal life of the saved, and the eternal punishment of the lost.
