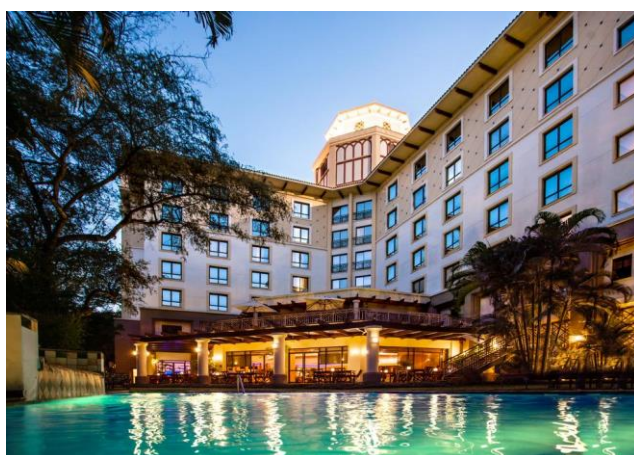

ACCOMMODATION

TRANSPORTATION

Participants are kindly requested to arrange their own transportation upon arrival in Dar es Salaam. Kindly note that Julius Nyerere international airport - is located approximately 10 km from the city centre. There are plenty taxis that operate between the airport and the City Center. For safety reasons we strongly advise you to use licensed Uber taxi services as they are reliable and secure. You will find these at the taxi area on the left-hand side when you walk out of the arrival terminal. Please do not take any taxi offered by people in front of the gates (if any) and just look for the taxi area. If you need to hire out a taxi from the hotel, kindly ensure that the arrangements are made at the hotel reception. Thus, the name/car registration, etc. of the drivers used will be well known at the hotel.

VISA INFORMATION FOR TANZANIA

All travelers who need a visa for Tanzania are requested to obtain their entry visa from the nearest available Tanzanian Embassy/Consulate, prior to departure to Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. For further information for visa requirements please kindly refer to the Tanzanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. UNLP holders do not need visas to enter Tanzania. Please note that the UNLP is recognized only together with a national passport.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Climate and weather

Current weather is hot with some rains expected during the visit. Temperatures range between 25 and 30 degrees.

Currency

The official currency in Tanzania is Tanzania Shilling. There are exchange desks in many areas of Dar es Salaam. Major hotels accept credit cards and cash point machines are available throughout the city. The exchange rate in free market is approximately (June 2019): \$1 for 2,295 TSh with minor fluctuations from day to day. It is advised not to use freelance exchange persons who offer to exchange currency around airports, train stations and in main city centers. The exchange rate is mostly reliable in the banks and usually lower in the hotels. Counters for money exchange of some banks can be found at the Julius Nyerere International Airport. ATMs are also found in these areas. US\$ or other currencies are legally accepted in the market.

Power voltage

220 Volts, 50 Hz. 3-Pin or 2-flat standard plugs work throughout Tanzania.

Time zone

The country time zone is GMT+3 throughout the year. There is no day-light saving time zone.

Communications

The country code is +255. Tanzania mobile operators cover almost the whole territory of the country. Some areas such as airport, restaurants, and malls have WI-FI zones that enable visitors to use the Internet.
