

Recruitment Agencies in Birmingham and the West Midlands

This listing has been compiled to give students and graduates details of recruitment agencies in Birmingham and the West Midlands area. Recruitment agencies

If you plan to use recruitment agencies, bear in mind that many require at least six to 12 months of relevant work experience. Agencies can be useful for helping you secure permanent employment as well as temporary employment, to gain work experience or some extra cash. You will usually be required to send your CV in order to register with them and perhaps have an initial appointment or interview with the firm.

Meeting with them in person allows you to discuss your needs, it helps them remember you and therefore keep you in mind for opportunities and it gives you the opportunity to ask any questions that you might have.

Increasingly, agencies will allow you to register and will accept your CV via the Internet. However, they may receive many registrations / CVs every day so it is important to follow this up with a phone call to introduce yourself and to discuss what you are looking for.

There are a few points to think about:

- Beware of agencies that charge you to register with them - this is against the law! You may find instead that an agency seeks to charge for additional services, such as CV preparation, selection tests etc. Be careful about this as well as agencies should not need to charge candidates for any of their services.
- Check if the agency belongs to a reputable trade organisation or professional organisation, such as the Recruitment and Employment Confederation or the Institute of Personnel Development.
- If the agency is operating on the Internet, check that any information you send will be confidential, that the agency has the type of employers you are looking for and that there are a number of these using the agency's services.
- If you're filling in an agency CV in a pre-set format, whether on the Internet or not, make sure that this presents you in a positive light and accurately reflects your skills and experience. The agency can only match you with vacancies on the basis of the information you give them. For further help with preparing an effective CV, bring a copy of your draft CV for checking at the CV Clinic.
- You can register with as many agencies as you like; you don't have to rely on just one. However, although it might seem like a good idea to register with numerous agencies, remaining selective means your time and energy is less likely to be wasted and allows you to maintain control of who your CV is being sent to. Keep in regular contact with each agency in order to keep track of the progress they are making in finding you a job. Keep a record of the contact you have had with each one - you don't want to find that more than one agency has put you forward for the same position!

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Recruitment agencies may be either multi-discipline agencies, handling vacancies across a wide range of business sectors, or specialist, recruiting only in certain fields, dealing with permanent or temporary positions, or both. So it is important you do your research and select the right agency for you. Newspapers and specialist journals will often contain advertisements from larger specialist agencies. Even if the job being advertised is not exactly what you want, you could still try contacting them to see if they have anything else more appropriate to your skills and experience. Agencies may talk to you about positions that you hadn't necessarily thought of applying for previously. This can be useful, but do be firm and clear about the career path you wish to follow.

If you are trying to find the names of agencies you could use, The Recruitment and Employment Confederation website (www.rec.uk.com) can be searched by company name, location and business sector. Their Jobsafe initiative can provide you with details on your rights as an agency worker as well as a guide to getting the most out of your relationship with your agency.

Top tips for using agencies:

- Create a good impression and act professionally – the agency will be encouraged to represent you and promote you to employers if they like you and are impressed with the way you conduct yourself.
- To make the most of agencies make sure you think about why you are using them and what you want to get out of the process before you start.
- Research and select your agency with consideration. If you can't ascertain if they're right for you from their website then talk to them.
- Don't be tempted to use too many at once – careful selection will mean your time is used most effectively.
- Keep in touch with them regularly. The agency environment can be fast-paced and if you don't keep in contact you may be overlooked. Having said that be careful not to pester.
- Make sure you are in control and you know what positions you are being put forward for. It can be helpful to keep a record of your applications – what they are for and through which agency. Ask to always be consulted before your CV is sent forward to an employer for a vacancy.
- Don't be persuaded to take on roles that you don't want to do.
- Remember flexibility may be required, recruitment through agencies can be fast-moving and you may be called to interview at short-notice.
- Some agencies will ask you if you will use them exclusively (i.e. you won't register with any other agencies). This normally happens when you have particularly marketable skills / experience.

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Agreeing to this can work in your favour to a certain extent as it creates goodwill and can incentivise them to find work for you. However, it is a good idea to give a time period during which you are prepared to do this e.g. 1-2 weeks for temporary work, a little longer for permanent work, so that they work hard for you during that time and you are then free to contact other agencies after this if things are moving slowly. If you have agreed to exclusivity, make sure that the agency is working proactively for you i.e. as well as informing you about vacancies they receive, they are contacting employers speculatively on your behalf to find out if they have any potential opportunities. In order to maintain control, you may want to agree a list of speculative employers first.

- Avoid giving specific information to your agency about applications you may have made directly yourself or through other agencies. Agencies are always on the look out for new vacancies to fill and will contact organisations if they have heard on the grapevine that they may be recruiting, so to avoid creating more competition for yourself, keep your cards close to your chest!
