<sup>5</sup>**Academic Supervision** requirement for graduation if first enrolled prior to 2018 spring (full-time start) or prior to 2017 fall (part-time start).

<sup>6</sup>**Academic Supervision** requirement for graduation if first enrolled in 2018 spring and after (full-time start) or in 2017 fall and after (part-time start).

<sup>7</sup>**Academic Supervision** requirement for graduation - minimum of six (6) courses - if first enrolled prior to 2018 spring (full-time start) or prior to 2017 fall (part-time start).

<sup>8</sup>**Academic Supervision** requirement for graduation \*OR\* GPA is below 3.2. in final fall/spring semester.

<sup>9</sup>Required for graduation if first enrolled in 2018 spring and after (full-time start) or in 2017 fall and after (part-time start).

<sup>10</sup>Enrollment requires completion of first thirty (30) hours of required courses, but not more than sixty (60) hours.
