

Cookie policy

1. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file (often including a unique identifier), that is sent to a user's browser from a website's computers and stored on a user's computer's hard drive or on a tablet or mobile device. A Cookie stores a small amount of data therein about your visit to the Site.

2. How do we use cookies?

We use cookies in order to improve your experience from the use of our websites and IT tools. We do not use the information for advertising or other commercial purposes.

We use only session cookies on our website and our applications.

Our cookies include:

- Technical Cookies are necessary for browsing in our websites (eg. Projex-online, working areas, Iprojex). These cookies store information about the authenticated user and disappear when the session is closed.
- Cookies for measuring traffic (Google analytic), Please see below specifically for Google analytics. These Cookies are stored by CEN and CENELEC up to 14 months.
- "Social media" Cookies which allow you to share information from the CEN and CENELEC websites and on social media such as Facebook or Twitter. These cookies are stored by CEN and CENELEC for up to 14 months.

In case you will access other organisation's websites through the CEN and CENELEC websites, then please be advised that such organisations privacy policies will apply.

3. How we use Google Analytics

Purpose: These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use of our websites. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve this website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including information on the number of visitors to this website, from where visitors came to this website and the pages they visited.

Cookie owner: third party

Cookie type: analytics / performance cookie

Information: The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States.
