Taking Concurrent Classes Policy

Rationale

Forest Charter School believes that better learning occurs when the knowledge and skills learned in one class builds to the next class. In order to support this philosophy, Forest Charter School has adopted the following policy.

Policy

- Students are not allowed to take classes in the same subject concurrently.
- For example, a student may not take Algebra 1 and Geometry during the same semester.
- However, if the student wishes to apply for an exception, he or she must petition the High School Review Board.
