



BROWNWOOD HIGH SCHOOL LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2019

The Brownwood High School Local Scholarship Application will be used for students wishing to apply for the following scholarships. Please read and keep this cover page for your information.

Bob Nevill Soccer Scholarships – The Bob Nevill Soccer Scholarships will award two graduating senior varsity soccer athletes, one male and one female, scholarship awards in the amount of \$5,000 each. Students wishing to apply for this scholarship must be a graduating senior maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0 in addition to being a varsity soccer player. The awards will be determined by committee.

Bob Nevill Academic Scholarship – The Bob Nevill Academic Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded a graduating senior of high academic distinction. Students wishing to apply for this scholarship must be a graduating senior maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.25 GPA in addition to being in the top 10% of the senior class. The scholarship will be determined by committee selection.

Cen-Tex Body and Paint Scholarship - Cen-Tex Body and Paint will award a \$1,000 scholarship to one student. The applicant must be a graduating senior planning to attend a vocational or technical school starting in the fall, after graduation. The winner will be determined by a committee including vocational instructors from BHS, and decisions will be based upon student merit. This scholarship may only be used for tuition, books, or other fees.

Davis Morris Scholarship – Davis Morris Funeral Home will award a \$500 scholarship to one graduating senior at BHS. The applicant must be a graduating senior planning to attend a college or university starting in the fall after graduation.

Jim and Frances Capps Scholarship – The Jim and Frances Capps Scholarship in the amount of \$436 is awarded each year to a distinguished graduate. Those wishing to apply must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and must be accepted to a two or four-year college/university or vocational/technical school. The scholarship will be determined by committee selection.

Texas Bank Scholarships – Texas Bank will award qualified graduating high school seniors with 5 individual scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to be used for tuition at any accredited college, university or vocational training school. Recipients must be enrolled as full-time students in a college, university or vocational training school in the fall of the year the scholarship is awarded. Criteria for the scholarship includes academic achievement, good moral character, extracurricular involvement, citizenship and the written application. There will be no discrimination based on age, sex, race, religion, color, ethnic origin, sexual preference, parent's employment or economic status.

West Central Wireless Scholarship – West Central Wireless will award a \$500 scholarship to one student. The applicant must be a graduating senior planning to attend a college or university starting in the fall after graduation. The winner will be determined by a committee based upon student merit and financial need. Students can receive no more than \$1,000 inclusive of this award in scholarships in order to qualify. This scholarship may only be used for tuition, books, or other fees.

Scholarship checks will be made payable directly to the university, community college, junior college or technical school in the name of the student awarded the scholarship. Students receiving scholarship awards will be given additional instructions for guaranteeing payment of the scholarship(s). All scholarship recipients are expected to turn in a hand-written thank you note addressed to the sponsor of the scholarship, postage included, prior to release of funds.
