How it works	<p>The discovery phase is the first steps in a project where we deep dive into the functionality, analyze the requirements, and lay out the project plans that we'll follow to completion. We'll help turn these into formal requirements, size up the skillsets and implementation team needed. Then we layout a project timeline and milestones for development.</p> <p>In the end, the project discovery phase produces a blueprint that defines how the project will be implemented.</p>
