

SIXTH YEAR'S ROTATION SCHEDULES FOR 2019/2020

1. Follow one of the 4 program schedules to avoid difficulties when registering for exams via Neptun
2. Students who wish to perform their rotations in already accredited hospitals that are listed at <http://semmelweis.hu/english/education/english-language-program/official-forms/> in "Approved Health Institutes for 6th year Rotations (xls)" only need to submit the "Letter of acceptance" to the respective Semmelweis department, have it stamped and signed and turn it in or scan and email it to the Foreign Students' Secretariat.
Each separate „Letter of acceptance” must be received by the Foreign Students’ Secretariat at the latest one month prior to the start of the rotation program.
3. You can do rotations in university departments or in teaching hospitals
4. The „Letter of acceptance” must be approved by the Semmelweis department and submitted to the Foreign Students' Secretariat 1 month prior to the rotation at the latest
5. Final exams take place in the last week of the rotation or the week after
6. Taking a final exam during the last week of the rotation requires a proper Neptun exam registration.
Students with a valid exam registration can get the hospital to certify a week less of their respective rotation program.
